Grade levels listed below refer to upcoming Fall 2009 grades.

Students currently in an Elementary Ballroom dance program should take camp G (This is designed for you!)

Current 6th grade ballroom dance students can also take camp A and/or H

Students on DCB Teams who JUST started ballroom THIS year should take Camp G, A and/or H

Students on DCB Teams who have taken ballroom for 2 + years (including this year) take camp C, D, H and/or A

Students who have taken a High School or Jr. High Social Dance class IN SCHOOL should take camp H and/or A

Beginners... Ages 8-10 = camp B • Ages 10-12 = camp F • Ages 12-18 = camp E
